In accordance with Order No. 587-T, issued February 24, 2009, 126 FERC ¶ 61,129 (2009), Western Gas Interstate Company ("WGI") hereby submits for filing an original and five (5) copies of the following proposed tariff sheet as part of its FERC Gas Tariff, to be effective August 1, 2009:

Statement of Nature, Reason, and Basis

In Order No. 587-T, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") amended its regulations that establish standards for interstate natural gas pipeline business practices and electronic communications, requiring pipelines to incorporate by reference the most recent version of the standards, Version 1.8, developed by the Wholesale Gas Quadrant of the North American Energy Standards Board ("NAESB"). Section 30 of WGI's General Terms and Conditions has been revised to refer to and incorporate the applicable Version 1.8 standards.

In 2003, the Commission granted WGI a limited waiver of the interactive website requirement of the Commission's regulations until such time as a Part 284 shipper requests the company to accept electronic communications and implement transactions through its website. *Western Interstate Pipeline Co.*, 104 FERC ¶ 61,306 (2003). Since the issuance of this order, WGI has received no such requests from its customers. Similarly, since 2003, there have been no requests to release capacity and no capacity releases on the system. Accordingly, WGI does not support and is not proposing to incorporate NAESB standards and datasets associated with the Electronic Data Interchange, Electronic Delivery Mechanisms, or Flat File Delivery Mechanisms.


